Collins Elementary School is host to a program funded by the State of Michigan. This program is set up and run through the Kent Intermediate School District (KISD). Teachers are certified and hired by KISD, but work very closely with our building principal and office on procedures, etc.

Great Start Readiness is a

free program made possible by state funding. It is available to four-year old children who meet financial and other eligibility criteria. Children must be 4 on or before September 1, 2016 for next Fall enrollment.

GSRP is play based preschool program, working on managing group play behavior and gross/fine motor skills.

Please make sure your child is current with his/her vaccines by contacting your health care provider. The following additional vaccines are required for all students prior to entering sixth grade this fall:

- Meningitis (MCV4)
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap booster)

The following vaccines are recommended for students ages 11-18:

Human Papillomavirus

(HPV) – males

- Annual flu vaccine
- Meningitis (MCV4)
- Tetanus, Diphtheria,
 Pertussis (Tdap)
- Hepatitis A
- Varicella (chickenpox booster)
