

## Junior Kindergarten/Kindergarten Early Entrance Form

In compliance with Public Act 198, children who reside within the Forest Hills Public School District and turn 5 years old between September 2 and December 1 may be considered for early entrance into junior kindergarten or kindergarten. This opportunity is intended for children who show signs of readiness to begin school ahead of the standard age.\*

Parents or legal guardians who wish to request early entrance must submit written notification to their child's

school principal. To initiate the process, please complete this form and return it to the school. - \* Junior Kindergarten is the first year of a two-year kindergarten experience. After completing junior kindergarten, students will continue on to traditional kindergarten.
