Dear Forest Hills Families,

Thank you for your support as we wrap up our first week of a new year of learning! The purpose of this letter is to share information on two topics: COVID-19 transmission and a long-term plan for our K-6 families.

**COVID-19 Transmission** - The Kent County Health Department reports that the current drivers of COVID-19 transmission are teenagers and people in their 20's. Indoor gatherings of friends who are not socially distancing and not wearing face coverings are driving transmissions. As we begin a holiday weekend, please remain vigilant and continue practicing the mitigation strategies of wearing face coverings, social distancing, and washing hands. These proven mitigation methods will allow us to keep our schools open and increase the amount of in-person learning. Let's keep our kids in school!

**Elementary Program Update** - Our hybrid plan worked well at the K-6 level this week. Students are adjusting to the new procedures and teachers are making strong progress getting to know students and beginning to understand their learning needs. Here is our plan for returning to a normal school schedule for all K-6 students.
